

CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will attend and participate, with a good attitude, in all classes, team meetings, devotional times, and activities during training and on mission.
- I will accept the authority of my team leaders, church representatives, mission hosts, and Street Invaders staff and I promise to follow their leadership.
- I will go as a servant-disciple of Jesus Christ. I will serve in any way that I am reasonably asked.
- I will give my phone to my leaders when I arrive at the program. My expectation is that I will have access to my phone for a maximum of two-hours a day for the duration of both training and mission. I understand that I will not always have access to Wi-Fi during that two-hour time frame. My parents will be able to communicate with me any time by calling my team leader or a Street Invaders representative (whose number will be sent to them during mission training). I understand that I am not permitted to use my phone to watch pornography, to participate in cyberbullying, or to engage in inappropriate activity. If I do, I understand that my phone may be confiscated, and my parents will be notified.
- I will refrain from meddling, complaining, gossiping, and obscene language, or insensitive humour (we get it, it is fun to tease each other – please don't cross the line). I understand that living in a close community of non-family members, can be difficult, and I promise to be flexible as plans may need to be changed. I will make every effort to exhibit civil behaviour with my team and leaders.
- I will respect and follow safety guidelines that are in place to protect my team members and me.
 - I will stay with my leaders and not wander off on my own.
 - I will dress in a way that is respectful of the culture that I am entering into whether it is a small farming community in Canada or a large urban setting overseas. I will follow the guidance of my leaders on this matter.
- I will interact with everyone on my team and make every effort to get to know my teammates regardless of the differences we may have or any way we disagree. I understand that bullying will not be tolerated at Street Invaders and participating in bullying of any kind is grounds to be sent home.
- I will refrain from giving gift items or money to others without checking with my leader.
- I will not use tobacco or vaping products, recreational/illegal drugs, or alcohol during my time on Street Invaders and I will not bring or purchase any of these items.
- If I am on any prescription medication I will fill out a medication information sheet and inform my leader.
- I will not do anything to encourage or pursue any romantic relationship while on Street Invaders. If I am already in a relationship when I arrive at Street Invaders, I will not allow my relationship to distract me from what the Lord has for me during the program.
- I will follow the Street Invaders training and mission guidelines as they are outlined to me on the first day of the program. (Please email the office for a copy of the street Invaders guidelines).
- I have read the Statement of Faith and I will conduct myself according to its values.
- Street Invaders has been working with young people for over 30 years! We have worked with thousands of teenagers. We have noticed that anxiety, depression, and unwillingness to listen to leaders are the areas with the highest potential to cause issues on teams. We are always hopeful that the Lord helps in these areas. If any of these apply to you, please be encouraged that we believe in you, we love you, and we want you to come to Street Invaders – that is our part. Here is your part: I agree that if I am feeling anxious, discouraged, depressed, or frustrated with people I will talk to my leaders and do everything I can to be healthy, to fight for myself (because I am worth it), and to work with my team.
